

Welcome to Farm Camp! We are so excited that you have chosen to attend the 19th year of Farm Camp here at Benton Family Farm. Thank you for trusting us with your child this summer. We will strive our best to make camp a fun, rewarding and safe environment.

Preparing for Farm Camp



Farm Camp is a place for kids to embrace nature, get dirty and have fun. We believe that giving children a chance to be in nature, regardless of the elements, creates a confidence in themselves and their surroundings.

Please remember to dress appropriately:

- Please wear shoes that can dirty and/or wet
- A change of clothes, including shoesjust in case your child doesn't like to be wet or dirty. Many kids choose to just stay wet to help keep them cool at fishing or in the afternoon sun.
- Please apply sunscreen before signing your child in. We will reapply sunscreen after lunch
- Closed toed shoes are necessary for safety. No Crocs, sandals or flip flops are allowed for normal farm

activities

- We do tend to get wet at least once during the day at camp (to beat the heat). Adding a plastic bag for wet clothes (if your child changes) and a towel to the bag they bring was found helpful in our first week of camp. This is not required though.
- A light sweatshirt or jacket may be needed depending on the weather
- Clothes will get dirty. Please do not send your child in clothes that you wouldn't want stained

We do have a lost and found bin at camp that we will put items into each day. It does help if your child's items are labeled so that if lost, we can return their items to them promptly.



- -Sign in for camp begins at 9:30 am and we will begin camp around 9:45 AM.
- -Upon arrival, please park in the grass lot across from the white farmhouse and walk up to sign your child in for the day.
- -An adult must sign your child into and out of camp each day. Please be sure that at check in, we have the appropriate name for the person who will pick up your child.
- -Camp pick-up is at 2:45 PM.
- -IF you have a late drop off or early pick up, please let our staff know ahead of time so that we can accommodate to your needs.
- -It is possible that your child will want to show you around a bit after camp, and that is totally okay! We love when campers show their family what they have learned. We do ask that campers leave no later than 3:00 so that staff can complete their farm chores.

Electronics Policy

Please leave all electronics at home. We are constantly on the move, getting dirty and/or wet. If an electronic device does come to camp, there is a real possibility of it being damaged or ruined.

Inclement Weather

If it's storming during drop off or pick-up, please drive back to the gathering barn to sign in/out.

We will stay outside, even if raining, if possible. If storms are in the area, we will move indoors. We try our best to then bring farm animals indoors and continue learning, but please be aware that we cannot control the weather.
